High-Speed Rail Lines

Just arriving? Or going further afield? Be sure to take advantage of the 800 miles of track that were just laid for our state-of-the-art, high-speed rail line.

Zoom Car Sharing

Earlier this year, Meridien deployed a fleet of more than 2,000 electric cars that can be picked up and dropped off at rental stands around the city. By sharing cars we get more use out of each one. Just don't forget to keep an eye out for the nearest charging station!

Bike-sharing & Bike Lanes

Looking to get quickly from here to there? Meridien's bike-sharing program gives you convenient access to bicycles at various stations throughout the city.







Meridien's "Green Light" District

Water reclamation, solar paint, urban beekeeping, car-less streets—this neighborhood is the workshop and test lab for our sustainable city.

Sustainable Building Tour

Take a tour of the architectural sites that have been constructed by following Meridien's Off Grid standard. An Off Grid building doesn't need a heating boiler and uses 70% to 80% less energy than a conventional building.

Urban Beekeeping

Our brave urban honey pioneers have carved out a place for themselves, and their bees, in our city. Pick up the fruits of their careful labor at a corner market.
